



## **2020 SPECIAL ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

Prom and graduation are some of the most memorable events in the high school career. Sadly, the memories for students in this year's graduating class will be very different. American teens will find imaginative ways to celebrate and create some memories. But it won't be the same. National Foundation for Teen Safe Driving is sponsoring a special scholarship program to recognize some of the special achievements from students of the Class of 2020.

### **SCHOLARSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS**

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. ALL FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

#### **1. PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

National Foundation for Teen Safe Driving will grant a limited number of scholarships to eligible high school students graduating with the Class of 2020. NFTSD will award these scholarships to recognize and reward a student who demonstrated a commitment to support issues affecting youth safety, including driving and traffic safety, substance abuse, bullying, emotional abuse and violence prevention, and while maintain a high level of academic achievement. The winning recipients will receive a one-time, \$250 scholarship to be applied to qualified expenses, including graduate and undergraduate tuition, fees, books, and on-campus room and board. Funds are provided directly by National Foundation for Teen Safe Driving. Payments are issued by National Foundation for Teen Safe Driving, made payable to the student's approved college or university and mailed after July 18, 2020 directly to the accredited college or university last designated by the student.

#### **2. SPONSOR**

The Contest is sponsored by National Foundation for Teen Safe Driving, ("Sponsor") located at 955 US Hwy 9, South Amboy, New Jersey 08879.

#### **3. ELIGIBILITY**

This contest is open to high school seniors who are legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia, the U.S. Virgin Islands, and Puerto Rico, and have met the academic requirements to graduate high school as part of the Class of 2020.

Applicants should have a history of serving their community in a volunteer role.

Applicants must currently be in good academic standing and provide transcripts to support a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above.

Applicants must have a clean driving record (no moving violations and/or at fault traffic crashes,) and not been convicted of any crime.

The Contest is subject to federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

Scholarship funds are payable to the winner's college/university or certified trade school in the United States; winner must enroll for classes beginning no later than Spring 2021 session.

Winner selection is **NOT** based on financial need or demographic criteria.

Home-schooled students may apply as long as course of study is equivalent to that of a senior in high school.

#### 4. ENTRY DETAILS

Scholarship entries are **ONLY accepted online** through the **NFTSD** website ([www.nftsd.org/2020](http://www.nftsd.org/2020)) or the **So Let's do This** website ([www.soletsdothis.org/2020](http://www.soletsdothis.org/2020)).

**Entrants must submit a completed entry form with all required information.** Before college scholarship funds will be awarded, all information submitted on the entry form by the entrant will be verified. If ANY false or misleading information is submitted on the entry form, the student will be disqualified without notification to the entrant. A complete entry will include:

  - Contact information
  - Brief description of your service

*Note: (This information is collected solely for the purpose of administering this contest, verifying information and notifying winners. We never share or sell your information with outside sources or vendors.)*

**Each entrant is allowed only ONE (1) ENTRY submittal.** Any attempt to enter again under a different name, address, etc., will automatically disqualify the entrant without notification to the entrant.

Entrants selected as winners are required to submit the name, contact information and anticipated start date of their chosen college/university/certified trade school (higher education)\* for verification of registration and payment of the scholarship to the school.

\*A 2- or 4-year college/university/technical/career/online school based in the United States that has completed & received accreditation from an agency recognized by the US Department of Education & is on the list found at <http://ope.ed.gov/accreditation> or <http://www.chea.org>

#### 5. WINNER SELECTION

All entries received during the contest period will be reviewed for contest eligibility.

Each complete eligible entry received during the entry period that has met the eligibility and entry criteria will be assigned a **unique entry number**.

Scholarship winners are **randomly selected by computer-generated drawing** from valid entries received at the conclusion of the contest period.

All **unique entry numbers** will be entered into RandomResult.com. Only the number assigned to the eligible entry form will be entered. No other information from the eligible entry form (including name, location, school information or other demographic information) will be used to select winners.

**Odds of winning are based on total number of entries received.**

Results are not related to the user, time or location.

## **6. PRIZES**

Sponsor will award a one-time \$250.00 scholarship to each eligible entry selected. A total of ten (10) scholarships will be awarded.

In the event that a winning entrant(s) is disqualified for any reason, that scholarship award will be forfeited, another random drawing of all remaining eligible entry numbers will be held, and all forfeited scholarships will be re-awarded.

## **7. WINNER NOTIFICATION**

Due to the number of entries received, NFTSD can only notify winners.

NFTSD will contact each winner by email and phone within fourteen (14) business days of contest end-date, using contact information provided by the entrant during the contest entry process. Winners have ten (10) calendar days from the date the notification email is sent to acknowledge receipt of the notification and verify they meet the eligibility requirements.

Once you are confirmed as winner, NFTSD will send you the appropriate college/university/trade school forms to complete for a check to be issued to your chosen school and deposited into your student account. No funds will be issued directly to individuals. All forms and processes must be completed within sixty (60) days of contest end date, or no later than thirty (30) days prior to the start of classes for student initial enrollment in college/university/certified in the Spring 2021 semester.

A 2- or 4-year college/university/technical/career/online school based in the United States that has completed & received accreditation from an agency recognized by the US Department of Education & is on the list found at <http://ope.ed.gov/accreditation> or <http://www.chea.org>

Winners' names will be posted on this web site in July 2020.

## **8. AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES**

Participation in the Contest constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sponsor, which are final and

binding. Winning a prize is contingent upon being compliant with these Official Rules and fulfilling all other requirements set forth herein.

## **9. CONTEST PERIOD**

The timeline for entries begins on June 1, 2020 and ends on June 30, 2020 at 11:59 PM Eastern (the "Contest Period"). Entries that are submitted before or after the Contest Period will be disqualified. Submissions will only be accepted for the duration of the Contest from the website addresses stipulated in [Section 4. ENTRY DETAILS](#)

NFTSD reserves the right to alter or discontinue this program at any time without notice.

## **10. GENERAL CONDITIONS**

In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Contest is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, bug, worm, unauthorized human intervention or other technical problem, or in the event the Contest is unable to run as planned for any other reason, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either (a) suspend the Contest to address the impairment and then resume the Contest in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules or (b) terminate the Contest and, in the event of termination, award the prize at random from among the eligible, non-suspect entries received up to the time of the impairment. The Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner.
